1.2.1	G	The purpose of \blacksquare GEN 1.2.2AR is to prevent <i>clients</i> being misled about the extent to which the <i>FCA</i> has approved a <i>firm</i> 's affairs.
1.2.2	R	[deleted]
1.2.2A	R	 Unless required to do so under the <i>regulatory system</i>, a <i>firm</i> must ensure that neither it nor anyone acting on its behalf claims, in a public statement or to a client, expressly or by implication, that its affairs, or any aspect of them, have the approval or endorsement of the <i>FCA</i> or another competent authority. Paragraph (1) does not apply to a <i>firm</i> to the extent that it is incompatible with obligations under article 44(8) of the <i>MiFID Org Regulation</i>. Paragraph (1) does not apply to statements that explain, in a way that is fair, clear and not misleading, that: (a) the <i>firm</i> is an <i>authorised person</i>; (b) [deleted] (c) the <i>firm</i> has permission to carry on a specific activity; (d) an <i>authorisation order</i> has been made in relation to an <i>AUT</i>, <i>ACS</i> or <i>ICVC</i>; (e) a <i>recognised scheme</i> has that status; (f) the <i>firm</i> is approved persons have been approved by the <i>appropriate regulator</i> for the purposes of section 59 of the <i>Act</i> (Approval for particular arrangements); (g) the <i>firm</i> has been given express written approval by the <i>appropriate regulator</i> in respect of a specific aspect of the <i>firm</i>'s affairs. Paragraph (1) applies with respect to the carrying on of both <i>regulated activities</i> and <i>unregulated activities</i>.

- **1.2.3 G G G G G G G G E N 1.2.2AR(2)(g)** is confined to written approval because of the need for clarity as to the scope of any approval given by the *appropriate regulator*.
- **1.2.4 G** A firm that carries on *MiFID*, equivalent third country or optional exemption business should have regard to the requirement in article 44(8) of the *MiFID* Org Regulation which is reproduced at COBS 4.5A.16UK.
