8.7 **Varying waivers**

- 8.7.1 Once the appropriate regulator has given a waiver, it may vary it with the firm's consent, or on the firm's application. If a firm wishes the appropriate regulator to vary a waiver, it should follow the procedures in ■ SUP 8.3.3 D, giving reasons for the application. In a case where a waiver has been given to a number of firms (see ■ SUP 8.3.10 G), if the appropriate regulatorwishes to vary such waivers with the consent of those firms, it will follow the procedures in ■ SUP 8.3.10 G.
- 8.7.2 G If the waiver that has been varied has previously been published, the appropriate regulator will publish the variation unless it is satisfied that it is inappropriate or unnecessary to do so, having regard to any representation made by the firm.
