		15A.9 Supervisory review and feedback
15A.9.1	G	The FCA may provide individual guidance as to whether a firm's compliance with this chapter is adequate and, if necessary, require a firm to take the necessary actions or steps to address any failure to meet the requirements in this chapter.
15A.9.2	G	A <i>firm</i> should have regard to the views provided by the FCA in relation to the <i>firm's</i> compliance. If a <i>firm</i> considers that any individual <i>guidance</i> given to it is inappropriate to its circumstances it should, consistent with <i>Principle</i> 11 (Relations with regulators), inform the FCA that it disagrees with that <i>guidance</i> . The FCA may reissue the individual <i>guidance</i> if, after discussion with the <i>firm</i> , the FCA concludes that the appropriate actions or steps a <i>firm</i> should take is different from that initially suggested by the FCA.
15А.9.3	G	If, after discussion, the FCA and a <i>firm</i> still do not agree, the FCA may consider other tools available to it, including its powers under sections 55J and 55L of the <i>Act</i> on its own initiative to require the <i>firm</i> to take specific steps in line with the <i>FCA's</i> view to comply with the requirements in this chapter.
