	27.4 General material about the scope of the certification regime
	Fundament
27.4.1 G	(1) The certification regime only applies to an <i>employee</i> .
	<ul> <li>(2) This definition includes a <i>person</i> who:</li> <li>(a) personally provides, or is under an obligation personally to provide, services to the <i>firm</i> in question under an arrangement made between the <i>firm</i> and the <i>person</i> providing the services or another <i>person</i>; and</li> </ul>
	(b) is subject to (or to the right of) supervision, direction or control by the <i>firm</i> as to the manner in which those services are provided.
27.4.2 G	(1) A <i>person</i> who works for an <i>appointed representative</i> of a <i>firm</i> may fall into the certification regime. In practice, however, they may not meet the conditions for the certification regime to apply.
	<ul> <li>(2) One condition for the certification regime to apply to a <i>person</i> is that the <i>person</i> performs a <i>certification function</i> under an arrangement entered into by the <i>firm</i> (see ■ SYSC 27.2.3G). However, unlike the equivalent parts of the <i>Act</i> for the <i>approved persons</i> regime, the <i>Act</i> does not say that the certification regime applies if the function is performed under an arrangement entered into by the employee with a contractor of the <i>firm</i> instead of the <i>firm</i>.</li> </ul>
	(3) The certification regime only applies if the <i>person</i> concerned is an <i>employee</i> . This is defined in ■ SYSC 27.4.1G. In many cases, a <i>person</i> working for an <i>appointed representative</i> will not fall into this definition as they may not:
	(a) provide services to the <i>firm</i> ; or
	(b) be subject to (or to the right of) supervision, direction or control by the <i>firm</i> .
	(4) If none of these limitations on the scope of the certification regime apply, a <i>person</i> working for an <i>appointed representative</i> will be

		subject to the certification regime, as long as the other conditions in this chapter are met.
27.4.3	G	<b>Effect of PRA requirements</b> A function does not cease to be an <i>FCA certification function</i> if that function is also a <i>PRA certification function</i> .
