FPCOB is relevant both to funeral plan providers and funeral plan intermediaries. FPCOB applies as described in this chapter unless the application of a chapter, a section or a rule is described differently in the chapters, sections or rules in FPCOB.
1.1.2	G	Purpose The purpose of <i>FPCOB</i> is to set out the detailed obligations that are specific to <i>regulated funeral plan activities</i> and the connected activities carried on by <i>firms</i> . ■ FPCOB 17 refers to other high-level obligations in the <i>FCA Handbook</i> that apply to <i>firms</i> , for example, <i>PRIN</i> , <i>GEN</i> and <i>SYSC</i> .

		1.2 General application: who? what? where?
1.2.1	R	Providing funeral plan contracts This sourcebook applies to a <i>firm</i> with respect to the activities of:
		(1) entering as provider into a funeral plan contract; and
		(2) carrying out a funeral plan contract as provider; and
		activities connected with them.
1.2.2	G	The regulated activities of entering as provider into a funeral plan contract and carrying out a funeral plan contract as provider apply in relation to funeral plan contracts under which the provider undertakes to provide, or secure that another person provides, a funeral in the United Kingdom (article 59(2) of the Regulated Activities Order and see PERG 2.4.2AG).
		Distributing funeral plan contracts: firms and appointed representatives
1.2.3	R	This sourcebook applies to a <i>firm</i> with respect to <i>funeral plan distribution</i> and activities connected with <i>funeral plan distribution</i> .
1.2.4	R	A firm (including a funeral plan provider) that has appointed an appointed representative to carry on funeral plan distribution must ensure that its appointed representative complies with this sourcebook as it applies to a firm carrying on funeral plan distribution.
1.2.5	G	A funeral plan provider that wishes to appoint an appointed representative to distribute its funeral plan contracts should ensure that the regulated activities covered by the appointed representative's appointment fall within the scope of the firm's Part 4A permissions or are otherwise excluded from being regulated activities when carried on by the firm (see SUP 12.4.1AG).
1.2.6	R	 Financial promotions This sourcebook applies to a <i>firm</i>: (1) communicating a financial promotion in relation to a funeral plan contract or a regulated funeral plan activity to a person inside the United Kingdom; and

		(2) approving a financial promotion in relation to a funeral plan contract or a regulated funeral plan activity for communication to a person inside the United Kingdom.

		New, subsisting and transferred funeral plans
1.2.8	R	All of the <i>rules</i> in this sourcebook apply in relation to <i>new funeral plans</i> , unless otherwise stated.
1.2.9	R	The <i>rules</i> in certain sections of this sourcebook also apply in relation to <i>subsisting funeral plans</i> .
1.2.9A	R	Any references in this sourcebook, other than that at \blacksquare FPCOB 16.1.5R(3)(e), to a transfer of a <i>funeral plan contract</i> or a transfer of the business of a <i>funeral plan provider</i> should be read to include circumstances where <i>funeral plan contracts</i> are transferred using the mechanism referred to in \blacksquare FPCOB 10.2.2R.

1.2.10	R	A Gibraltar-based firm with permission for funeral plan provision activity or funeral plan distribution must comply with the relevant provisions of FPCOB and any other provisions in the Handbook relating to regulated funeral plan activity.

1.2.11	G	<i>Guidance</i> on the application provisions is in E FPCOB 1 Annex 1.
1.2.12	G	Customers and covered individuals (1) In this sourcebook, <i>rules</i> may apply by reference to the <i>customer</i> or <i>covered individual</i> under a <i>funeral plan contract</i> , or to both.
		(2) The definition of <i>customer</i> includes a prospective <i>customer</i> under a
		funeral plan contract.
		(3) Reference to the covered individual is to the individual on whose death a funeral will be provided or secured under a funeral plan contract or prospective funeral plan contract. The covered individual under a funeral plan contract will not necessarily be the same person as the customer (article 59(2)(b) of the Regulated Activities Order).

- **1.2.13 G** Where the *rules* in this sourcebook require a *firm* to disclose information to a *customer*, the *firm* should also consider:
 - (1) whether it should disclose the same information to the *covered individual* (where different from the *customer*) in accordance with its obligations under *Principle* 7; and
 - (2) if it considers that disclosure should be made to the *covered individual*, whether it requires the consent of the *customer* in order to make that disclosure.
