Notification rules for UK recognised bodies



3.20 Disciplinary action relating to members

- 3.20.1 Where a *UK recognised body* has taken any disciplinary action against any member or any employee of a member, in respect of a breach of a rule relating to the carrying on by the UK recognised body of any of its regulatory functions, that body must immediately notify the FCA of that event, and give:
 - (1) the name of the person concerned;
 - (2) details of the disciplinary action taken by the UK recognised body;
 - (3) the *UK recognised body*'s reasons for taking that disciplinary action.
- 3.20.2 R Where an appeal is lodged against any disciplinary action referred to in ■ REC 3.20.1 R, the *UK recognised body* must immediately give the *FCA* notice of that event, and:
 - (1) the name of the appellant and the grounds on which the appeal is based, immediately; and
 - (2) the outcome of the appeal, when known.

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
