## Chapter



- (1) The systems and controls that a supervised contributor is required to have in place pursuant to Article 16(2)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/1011 shall include training programmes to ensure that each submitter has:
  - (a) adequate knowledge and experience of how the benchmark is intended to measure the underlying market or economic reality;
  - (b) adequate knowledge of all the elements of the applicable code of conduct developed under Article 15(1) of that Regulation, if any.
- (2) The knowledge of submitters referred to in points (a) and (b) of paragraph 1 and of the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2016/1011 as well as Regulation (EU) No 596/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council, to the extent applicable to the tasks of the submitters, shall be re-assessed periodically, and in any event at least annually, to verify that it is still appropriate for each of them to act as submitters.
- (3) Paragraph 2 shall not apply in the case of supervised contributors of significant benchmarks.
